1864. A bath-house, now derelict, resembling a folly of Georgian type. Whitened stuccoed stone. Entrance gatehouse with flanking embattled 2-storeyed drum towers having 1 narrow light above and below. Round inscribed panel above square-headed entrance. A small curtain wall engages a low square tower on each side. Cell-like chambers are ranged on two sides of a small court, and an alley covered leads to the sea.
