HOLYHEAD, Nos 1 & 2 Tanallbran Cottages

II Circa 1891; built to the order of Miss Jane Henrietta Adeane and part of the same composition as Nos 1 and 2 Turkey Shore Road and Plas Tanallbran. 2 storeys with projecting end gables of two bays each, the east gable comprising No 1 and the west gable comprising former coffee shop, now (1979) part of No 2. Rubble walls of local stone. Slate gabled roofs. Hardwood mullioned windows. Altered upper face of projection comprising No 1 with pebbledash cladding to first floor and rendered cladding to gable. Modern four-light wood casement on first floor; on ground floor

original three light windows to left hand and modern half-glazed door to right hand.

Nb 2 is set back with overhanging eaves. To right hand, four light mullioned windows above and below, the ground floor windows with stone lintel. To left hand, half glazed modern door with small single light window above at eaves.

Former coffee shop gable with fake timber collar and half timbering above collar; two 3-light mullioned windows on first floor below the collar; on ground floor, former coffee shop front below to left hand with half glazed door and 3-light shop window with chamfered mullions; common oversight. To right hand, 4-light mullioned windows with stone lintel.

Blank east gable end to side of Nb. 1 with stone stack at end.
