

YNYS MON (former Valley Rural District)

LLANFAETHLU, Rectory, 400 yds south of church

- II c.1830, 2 storey rectory. 6 windows including central loggia entrance, at ground floor, with twin arches. Small wing to east. Rubble masonry. Slate roof with projecting eaves and verges. Recessed sash windows with glazing bars. South front, 7 windows including central 3 window splay bay. Interior: central paved hall with square gallery at 1st floor and circular lantern with enriched drum. Doors with 6 sunk panels. Window shutters with sunk panels. Cove cornices. Original stone mantel in SW room.

PLANNING HISTORY

The building was listed on 5/4/71. Prior to this date modifications are said to have taken place, they are ; (1) The original Kitchen was converted into a garage and fitted with a metal "up and over" door.

(2) The central paved hall has been replaced with a wood block floor.

(3) The original stone mantel in the South west room had been removed and a solid fuel cooker installed within the breast.
