II* 15C + 16C, remodelled and with addition, north, by Sir Thomas Holland in 1615. Hall has re-set early + late 17C panelling. 2 storeys + attic, 5 windows south. Uncoursed rubble masonry with massive quoin stones + bevelled plinth. Roof of old small slates. Tall square chimneys with dripstones and capping. Tower, with pyramidal roof. Meeled 3-light mullion transoms casements with weathered hood moulds. Entrance door has straight head with chamfered jambs and weather moulded hood bands, and inscribed tablet with shield of arms and date 1615. Walled front garden with arched doorways, one with shield of arms. Ref in RCAM p. 100
