II Rebuilt c. 1780 by Owen Rutland Meyrick, with alterations in 1860 and with later additions at rear. 2 storeys. Ashlar masonry with plinth and band at 1st floor level. Entrance front, north, 6 windows with coupled columns portico. 9 window garden front, east, with 3 window central bay. Above bay is saucer dome, of old small tiles. Recessed sash windows, now without glazing bars, on main fronts. Interior: circular room at ground floor at bay and at 1st floor with saucer domed ceiling. 6-panel doors remain at 1st floor and various original mantels. Curved staircase hall with cantilevered stone stair, and saucer domed lantern. Fine garden terraces.
