Outstanding Conservation Area

- A Mainly early C14, but chancel rebuilt and walls of aisles raised + battlemented C1500, E windows of aisles inserted early C16, 2 upper N. windows of chancel and N clerestory of nave added C1600. Upper stage of W tower remodelled early C19. All vestry and S porch modern. Roofs renewed but some original timbers + carved bosses. Nave of 4 bays. Tower of 4 stages. Choir stalls have some (damaged) carved desk-ends and C1400 misericord carvings. Numerous good monuments, including elaborate alabaster altar tomb of William (d. 1490) and Elizabeth Bulkeley by N. door (RCHM 1)
