BEAUMARIS, Llanfaes Parish, The Old Snitting

II Dated 1811. One storey. Paved rubble. Hipped roof of small old slates (for holed towards right). The snitting itself was on the left side, which has 3 symmetrically disposed openings with low, pointed heads of dressed stone, the centre one somewhat wider, with stable door, the others being windows (now boarded). The right-hand side of the building was a kitchen place, having 2 low, wide doorways with wooden lintels within and arched heads of dressed stone externally (that of the left one having fallen out). The interior of this section has several kitchen cups. A wing forming a house extends to the rear from the left-hand side. Of the same height + build, this has on the outer side 2 windows +

central door (all modernised), together with one right-hand window (now boarded) with cantered lead. Two old ridge chimneys but slates removed + renewed.
