long stone on top of cairn, latest recent augmentation
LONG, narrow orientated E-W at false crest. proximal end unexcavated
at N. 40cm H. at proximal end trailing to nothing at E.
W.D. 27 - spaced north-east boulders on the N side may be kerb / former
edges to the mound. loose stone at proximal end may be
clearance and/or disturbance
