Cromlech 1471

Probably the finest specimen of prehistoric sepulchral architecture in Great Britain if we omit Stonehenge.

Several rude stones placed upright in a circular form, & in the middle is one higher than the rest supported upon three stone pillar about 8 feet high. This is called by the Welsh 'Cromlech' which signifies bowing to the stone.
