Hut foundations 71 No. 2 Gatholm 2931 On the island of Gatholm we counted more than 100 hut foundations; these differed in several particulars from the so-called CYTIAN R GWYDDILOD found throughout Wales. The Gatholm foundations varied greatly in size and shape; one measured 30 ft by 12 ft. None of them were faced with stone. In addition to the hut foundations there

were eight enclosures, the largest measuring perhaps 1/8th of an acre. There were a considerable number of flint chips on the island but no water. Excepting at high tide, Gatholm can be approached from Marloes sands. Owen's Pembrokeshire, I, 112. Fenton, 163.
