Treginnis Copper Mine, St Davids - SM 715235 and 717232 -
openwork and shaft with short crosscut adit, at Cuba, opposite
Ramsey Island. Shaft at Porthtaflod, 400 yards to the south.
Worked for copper from c.1830 until 1883.

A small copper mine on cliff tops opposite Ramsey Island, 1000 yards
south west of Treginnis Isaf farmhouse.

Openwork, shaft and shallow adit (all open) on Penmaemelyn, called
Cuba in tithe award, with small structure, purpose unknown (ruin)
adjacent to shaft. To the south east at Porth Taflod was a shallow
shaft on the cliff top (filled).

Unsubstantiated reports of working c.1820; worked intermittently
up to 1883, abandoned after fatal accident.

Mine on very edge of cliff. Foundations of
two stone buildings are present, a small
quarry and a shaft approximately
10m deep. A track leads down to the
workings. The site is eroding into the
sea. Two small buildings named 'Cuba'
marked on the St Davids Tithe map.
