Images of Builth Wells

The photograph below shows Bank Square in Builth full to capacity with sheep pens during one of the regular livestock markets held in the town.



It was probably taken around 1900 when parts of the town were still being taken over by livestock brought in from the surrounding areas for sale. A specially built livestock market was eventually provided nearby on the Brecon road in 1910.

Below the image shows a cattle fair in progress in Builth High Street, possibly taken in 1905. This view is looking west along the High Street, with West Street visible in the background.

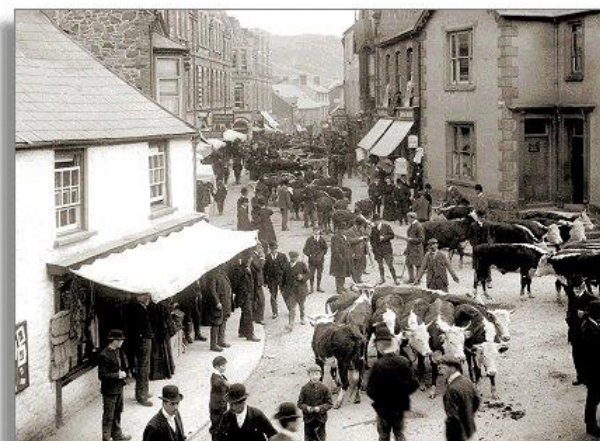


The photograph includes some interesting details. There are two men in uniform among the group at the bottom right of the picture, probably officials from the railway station over the bridge in Llanellwedd.

The young lad in white standing in front of them looks like he may have been working for a local shopkeeper - possibly a butcher's boy.

The sign above the drapers shop on the right reads "Hearse for hire".

The old Welsh name for Builth was Buelit, which derived from 'wild ox', and the town's symbol shows a bull with large horns. Although it is so closely connected with livestock farming, Builth did not have a market place for many years, and animals were bought and sold in the streets.



This picture was taken in High Street, Builth in 1905. It would have been difficult for farmers to keep their animals separate from others that were being sold because there were no enclosures as in livestock markets nowadays.

This is another early photograph of livestock for sale in the heart of Builth, with sheep enclosed in pens in for the weekly sheep market at Market Street.



The picture probably dates from around the same time as the photograph of the cattle fair - around 1900. Sheep were then traded in Market Street and Bank Square in Builth. The above view is looking down Market Street towards High Street and West Street, with Bank Square on the right.

Lluniau o Lanfair-ym-Muallt

Mae'r llun isod yn dangos Sgwâr y Banc yn Llanfair-ym-Muallt yn llawn dop o gorlannau defaid yn ystod un o'r marchnadoedd da byw rheolaidd a gynhaliwyd yn y dref.



Mae'n debyg i'r llun hwn gael ei dynnu tua 1900 pan fyddai rhannau o'r dref yn llawn anifeiliaid a ddaeth o'r ardaloedd cyfagos i'w gwerthu. Adeiladwyd marchnad da byw arbennig gerllaw ar Ffordd Aberhonddu yn 1910.

Mae'r llun isod a dynnwyd tua 1905 yn dangos ffair wartheg ar Stryd Fawr, Llanfair-ym-Muallt. Mae'r olygfa hon yn edrych tua'r gorllewin ar hyd y Stryd Fawr, gyda Heol y Gorllewin yn amlwg yn y cefndir.

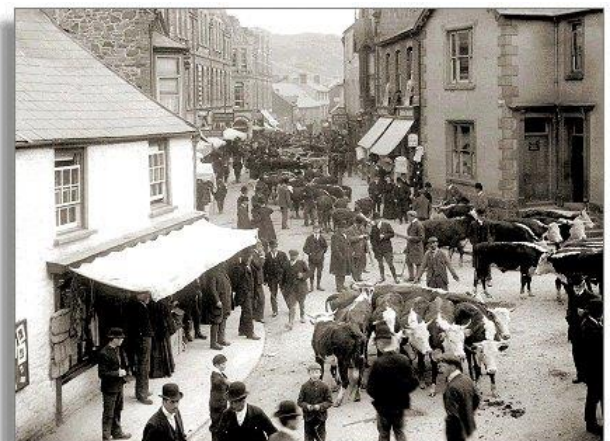


Mae'r llun yn cynnwys rhai manylion diddorol. Mae dau ddyn mewn gwisg arbennig ymhlith y grŵp ar waelod ochr dde'r llun – mwy na thebyg yn swyddogion o'r orsaf reilffordd dros y bont yn Llanellwedd.

Mae'r bachgen ifanc mewn gwyn sy'n sefyll o'u blaen yn edrych fel pe bai'n gweithio i siopwr lleol – bachgen cigydd falle?

Mae'r arwydd uwchben y siop ddillad ar y dde'n dweud "Hearse for Hire".

Yr hen enw Cymraeg am 'Built' oedd Buellt, sy'n deillio o 'ych gwyllt' ac mae arwydd y dref yn dangos tarw gyda chyrn mawr. Er bod gan y dref gysylltiadau agos â ffermio da byw, nid oedd yna farchnad yn y dref am nifer o flynyddoedd, a byddai'r anifeiliaid yn cael eu gwerthu a'u prynu ar y stryd.



Cafodd y llun hwn ei dynnu ar y Stryd Fawr yn 1905. Byddai wedi bod yn anodd i ffermwyr gadw'r stoc ar wahân o'r anifeiliaid eraill gan nad oedd llociau fel sydd mewn marchnadoedd heddiw..

Dyma lun cynnar arall o sêl da byw yng nghalon Llanfair-ym-Muallt, gyda defaid mewn corlannau ar gyfer y farchnad ddefaid wythnosol yn Stryd y Farchnad.
