I have been unable to find any reference to the slab I photographed in the Gresham book. I did find the following in George Vernon Price's Valle Crucis Abbey, p.137: "an early stone was used in forming the ceiling of the day-stairs when the dormitary was rebuilt in or about 1350." If this is the right one, then presumably it must predate 1350? Many thanks for your help, in any case.
